**PURPOSE OF THE REPORT:**

To inform the committee of the outcomes against the agreed plan for ES consortium

**KEY POINTS:**

The consortium has achieved a number of planned outcomes in year. The Public Health agenda has been a significant success with establishment of the Lifestyle team which in conjunction with Health Trainers will deliver a number of the PBC objectives over the coming years.

The management of the BHFT contract has become more robust over the year with successful clinical and technical challenges resulting in financial reduction in contract payments.

The corporate objective of delivering care in community settings has been progressed by the instigation of outreach services in Uttoxeter, the commissioning of Alcohol Detox beds in Burton town, the provision of various services from Hill Street Health and Well being centre and the development of a primary care LES for phlebotomy which is already demonstrating a shift in activity from Acute facilities into the community.
